Configure DSRWZP on the selected Server

Constraints on Zero Privilege (ZP) Requests

- Do not allow modification of accounts that include "ADMIN" anywhere in the distinguished name
- Do not allow modification of the following groups or accounts that are a direct member of the following groups: "Administrators"(builtin), "Domain Admins" or "Enterprise Admins"

Do not allow modification of the following Groups or their members including nested groups
